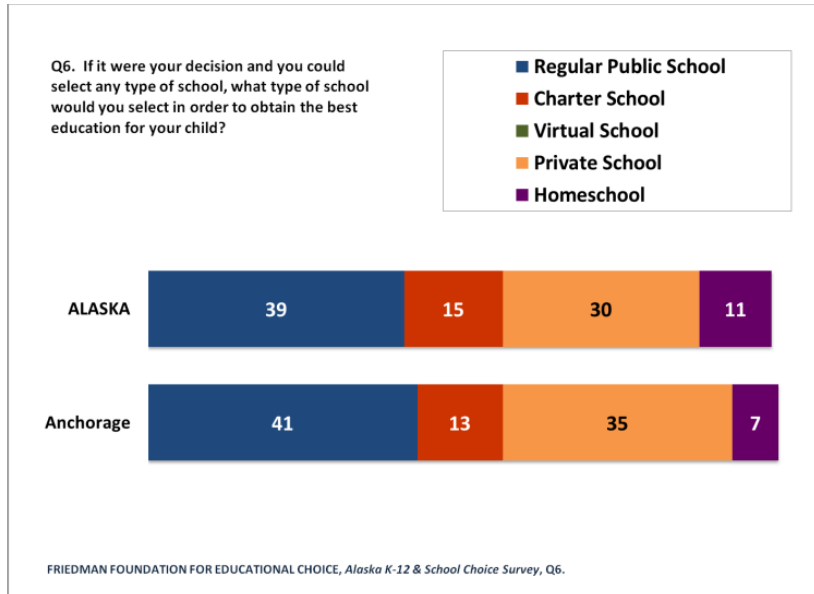


February is School Choice Month!
