COVID Update

- Since the start of the school year...
 - 4 student positive cases and 1 teacher positive case
 - 20+ parents and family member positive cases
- Our protocol:
 - Upon notification of positive case, thorough contact tracing by teachers to reduce number of student quarantines
 - Unvaccinated students can avoid quarantine by maintaining greater than 3-6 feet social distance AND properly wear mask
- School staff and I would like to keep our current protocols in place for rest of this semester and reevaluate over the Christmas holidays

Dress Code Trends

- Skirt length too short (Handbook states no more than 1” above the knee--front and back)
 - Long term remedy: Work with our uniform vendors for better fit and cut of our skirt
 - Short term remedy: Please ensure ladies wear tights/hose under skirts
- Dress Up for Mass
 - Majority of students looking very sharp and professional on Mass days, but some still “forget”
 - Remedy: “If you don’t dress up for Mass, you don’t dress down for Spirit or Casual Wear days.”
- Hair length
 - From Handbook: *“Both male and female hair must be professional, neat, and clean. Hair may only be a natural hair color, should not be of an excessive length, and should not hang below the eyebrow”*
- Warming Layer
 - No jackets worn around the building. Please wear Lumen fleece or Lumen sweater if cold!

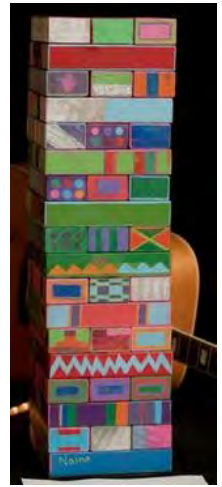
